ITEM #5

PUBLIC HEARING: Discussion and possible action to approve Resolution 2022-14: Vacating portions of a Vehicular Non-Access Easement (VNAE) for lots 6 and 9 of the Nighthawk on Black Mountain Subdivision and abandoning of the existing access and utility easements shared between these lots.

Planning Director, Stacey Bridge-Denzak presented background of the abandonment case at Nighthawk on Black Mountain subdivision.

Ms. Bridge-Denzak explained, the request is to vacate portions of a Vehicular Non-Access Easement (VNAE) for lots 6 & 9 of the Nighthawk on Black Mountain Subdivision and vacate the existing access easement shared between these lots. Displaying an aerial of the subject parcels, Director Bridge-Denzak pointed out that over time there has been disturbance within the easement that is to be vacated. Further explaining that the easement shall be revegetated with native plants that conform to the density of plants in the surrounding natural environment following utility removals.

Ms. Bridge- Denzak notified Council that all public participation requirements have been met and there was no opposition to the request.

Director Bridge-Denzak responded to questions from Council regarding the timeframe for revegetation in regard to the development of the two adjacent lots.

Vice Mayor Crane <u>MOVED TO APPROVE</u> Resolution 2022-14: Vacating portions of a Vehicular Non-Access Easement (VNAE) for lots 6 and 9 of the Nighthawk on Black Mountain Subdivision and abandoning of the existing access and utility easements shared between these lots.

With the following conditions:

- 1. Finalization of the abandonment of the utility easement shall occur after the approval of the Mountainside development application for the second of the two lots to be developed (Lot 6), which shall include an electrical service design.
- 2. All utility services shall be from Never Mind Trail'
- 3. All utility lines shall be located underneath or within 5 feet of each driveway.
- 4. Prior to issuance of a building permit, each property owner shall record a new document that rededicates the VNAE except for 20 feet at each driveway entrance.
- 5. The existing disturbance shall be revegetated with native plants that conform to the density of plants in the surrounding natural environment following utility removals.

SECONDED by Councilperson Hatcher. **CARRIED**, unanimously.

SUMMARY:

The Town of Carefree is seeking to retain a consulting firm to provide sign inventory services. A Request for Proposals (RFP) was published and opened on February 14, 2022. A total of four RFP's were submitted.

The Carefree Sign Inventory will include, but not be limited to, the data as shown below:

- Sign ID Number (to be added by surveyor)
- Sign Type Description
- MUTCD Sign Reference Number
- Sign Image (Google Earth or similar method)
- Location and Street Name (Latitude/Longitude and/or approximate distance to street intersection centerline)
- Side of Road / Direction Sign Faces
- Condition Assessment (Good, Fair, Poor)
- Sign size (inches x inches)
- Height of bottom of sign relative to edge of pavement
- Post type (wood, metal, other)
- Post quantity (quantity of posts for sign structure)
- Post shared with other signs (YES or NO)
- Post condition (good, bent, needs replacement, etc.)
- Notes about sign
 - Sign condition (bent, graffiti, holes, faded, etc.)

The Carefree Sign Inventory was placed in the Capital Improvement Plan to help the Town more efficiently place, remove, replace, inventory, and purchase traffic signs, warning signs, and guide signs placed on the public thoroughfares throughout the Town. The RFP was developed to accept the consultant's proposals and to come up with a budget figure for this assignment. The budget figure placed within the CIP was set at \$15,000.

The final product will include photos and data points of the deliverable signs, and access to the location of the signs in a Google Map vehicle allowing for multiple layers of map data. This mapping system can be used on any computer, laptop, or smart phone and be available to share with anyone with this type of a system.

Engineering Mapping Solutions, Inc/Y2K was picked as the most responsive RFP given their organization and approach, scope of work, and the attributes they had submitted. Their proposal came in under the budget number at \$13,500.

SECTION 3. ORGANIZATION AND APPROACH

EMS, led by Phil Ponce and Y2K, led by Keith Koprowski (Team) will jointly lead an introduction meeting with the Carefree project manager and any additional stakeholders that directly influence the scope of services and extent of the data collection area and required information EMS will collect. This will be an introduction to the importance of the project, a fact gathering session for issues and concerns, a development of the vision to guide the project process, and a chance to set the roles of each team member with a schedule and actionable items list. Meeting minutes with action items and a schedule for follow-up meetings will be distributed to all attendees and stakeholders to set the groundwork for the entire project.

EMS will establish a monthly conference call with the project manager and other stakeholders that would like to discuss the project progress and any actions that the Town may have interest in. Minutes from these calls will be provided to the Town project manager with updates on the schedule showing work tasks, phases, durations, milestones, assignments, and critical paths.

EMS will begin the sign inventory process by canvasing the Town with imagery to collect signage attributes to build a GIS database. We begin by driving each road in both directions using truck-mounted cameras positionally corrected with a Bad EIF GPS unit capable of sub-centimeter accuracy. Note that we will need to coordinate with Town staff to gain access to the main gated communities service by the Town.



Once the field imagery is collected, EMS technicians review each photo to gather locations and attributes of each sign. By reviewing the multiple images taken of each sign, EMS techs will have all the information necessary to capture the required attributes.



When the GIS is built by EMS, it is then handed to Y2K for the engineering assessment. Lastly, we will circle back with the Town for training and implementation provided by EMS.

The details of these steps are in the next section of the proposal.

SECTION 4. SCOPE OF WORK

Carefree is a unique semi-rural small town nestled among vegetated sloping foothills the Upper Sonoran Desert. The Town was master planned to be entirely distinctive from the surrounding communities. This distinction is reflected in many of the local street names, such as Easy Street, Ho Hum, Nonchalant and Peaceful Place.

The Town of Carefree maintains approximately 60 centerline miles of local roads, which contain an unknown number regulatory and warning signs. The scope of work for this project shall include survey of all regulatory, warning and guide signs in the Town's Road network. The actual number of signs is not known at this time by the Town but will be determined through the work requested.

The Team will apply GIS-based applications to capture data of signs as requested in the request for proposal such as location of signs, size, MUTCD compliance, mounting heights, and condition. This data will be published and provided to the Town in ArcGIS Online for consumption in WebApp Builder and EMSWebMap software.

Further, Y2K Engineering will also take the data points from the GIS database and establish a Google MY Map deliverable. Google's My Map tool allows you to load multiple layers of map data (point, line or area), change colors and symbols, and import photographs. Carefree will be able to share the resulting map with anyone using a web link and will be able to designate specific people as editors such that the database can be easily maintained. My Maps are also mobile-ready, which means they function correctly on your smart phone, not just on your computer.


The first phase of the project collects field imagery by EMS. Each image is methodically reviewed to provide the following attributes:

- A unique sign ID number
- A description of the sign type
- MUTCD code
- An image of the sign
- The location of the sign both by latitude and longitude along with the approximate distance to the nearest intersection
- The side of the road the sign is on, along with the direction the sign faces
- Information about if the sign post is shared with other signs
- The date the sign was surveyed



Our custom review tools and techniques leverage state-of-the-art programming techniques such as custom pull-down menus to ensure all data is entered properly and accurately.


The GIS information is stored with each database feature as shown below, and all fields are customized to the Town's specification.




After the initial database has been prepared by EMS, Y2K will complete an assessment, engineering field work, including sign sizes, heights, post and sign conditions.

- Condition Assessment (Good, Fair, Poor)
- Sign size (inches x inches)
- · Height of bottom of sign relative to edge of pavement
- Post type (wood, metal, other)
- Post quantity (quantity of posts for sign structure)
- Post shared with other signs (YES or NO)
- Post condition (good, bent, needs replacement, etc.)
- Sign condition (bent, graffiti, holes, faded, etc.)
- · Notes about sign.

Final delivery of data will be in many formats, as the Town needs. Our primary delivery will be in GIS format using browser-based web access. Below is an example of what is returned when you select a sign. Note that you can select the sign to retrieve the sign stack and an image of the sign.



Additionally, when you select an image point, you can then "walk" down the street seeing the same images we use to gather the inventory.



This approach allows Town web users to see the current status of their entire street network system when complete.

Project Closeout — Implementation and Training

The final step of the project is to train and implement the new system with Town users. We envision working with management as well as field staff to ensure the data is useable on their existing hardware, including mobile devices.

Our goal is to ensure the data is used properly and is scaleable for future application in both the office and the field. Our job will not be complete until you are completely satisfied with the entire process. To that end, we will work directly with town staff to ensure they can access, edit, and maintain the resulting datasets via ArcGIS Online and any desired mobile field applications.
