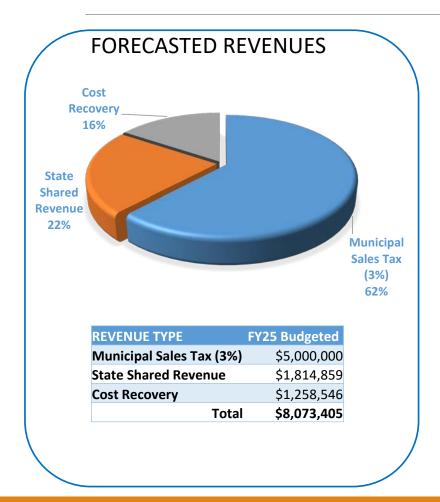

FY 2024-2025 BUDGET DASHBOARD





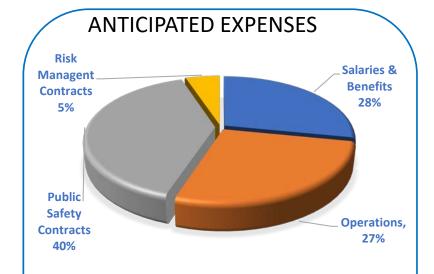
