The Town of Carefree is privileged to host its 13th annual Veterans Day celebration to honor our veterans on Thursday, Nov. 11, from 3-5 p.m., in the Carefree Desert Gardens, 101 Easy St., at the Sanderson Lincoln Pavilion stage.

Speakers will include Col. Craig Houk, US Army, retired, an Afghanistan War veteran who will share his wartime experiences and perspective and Lt. Mike Wold, US Navy Vietnam War veteran. This year's event will also feature a mixture of patriotic and military music by Todd Knowles and the Main Event Swing Band as well as "The Last Post" on the bugle, followed by "Taps" performed on dueling bugles.
